**JUDGMENT**

On May 22, 2002, the Court issued its findings and conclusions regarding the Plaintiff's Complaint and Motion for Preliminary Injunction. Based upon those findings and conclusions, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

1. The Defendant, Tauhidah F. El-Amin, is permanently enjoined from using the phrase "Amicus Curiae" in connection with her bankruptcy petition preparer business.

2. The Defendant, Tauhidah F. El-Amin, is permanently enjoined from collecting or receiving any payment from any of her customers for the court fees in connection with the filing of any bankruptcy petition.

3. The Defendant, Tauhidah F. El-Amin, is permanently enjoined from receiving a fee in excess of \$175 from a customer for preparing bankruptcy documents unless the

customer retains Defendant to prepare the documents based on a reasonable hourly rate and the actual time spent preparing the documents results in a larger fee.

4. The Defendant, Tauhidah F. El-Amin, shall within 30 days of the date of this Order turnover to the bankruptcy trustee any fee received from a bankruptcy customer in excess of \$175 by means of a cashier's check made payable to the Debtor(s), and the trustee shall forward the check to the Debtor(s) pursuant to Section 110(h)(2).
